

High Point Program Rules

1. Owner and rider must be members of Four Beats for Pleasure
2. Points will count from the time the Nomination and Membership forms are received. (For example, if forms are received after the day of the Dogwood Jubilee, points from the Dogwood Jubilee will not count)
3. Membership and Nomination forms received after June 1 will not be counted in that year's Year End Awards.
4. Points will be accumulated at the Dogwood Jubilee, Firecracker Jubilee, Liberty Bell Classic, & Harvest Jubilee.
5. Each horse/rider combination must designate **one** division in which they want to accumulate divisional points.
6. The same horse may be used in different horse/rider combinations. The same rider may be used in different horse/rider combinations. **Each combination must designate one division.**
7. One nomination form must be used for each horse/rider combination.
8. Points for horse/rider combinations will count toward divisional year-end awards only in classes that fall in the designated division. For example: Rider A/Horse A combination choose Trail Pleasure as their designated division. Any time that combination enters a Trail Pleasure class, point will accumulate. If that combination enters a Lite Shod class at the fun shows, those points will not accumulate for divisional awards.
9. Points will count toward Horse of the Year awards every time a nominated horse enters and shows in any class that counts toward year-end awards.
10. Points will count toward Rider of the Year awards every time a member rider enters and shows in any class that counts toward year-end awards.
11. Versatility points will accumulate any time a horse/rider combination enters a versatility class
