

Four Beats for Pleasure Scholarship Application Rules

- 1 The applicant must be a member of Four Beats for Pleasure for two(2) years (the date of membership will be the date application/fees are received by the membership chairperson).
- 2 Applicants must be a graduating senior from high school or be enrolled in post secondary education or in graduate school
- 3 All current members are eligible to apply, including past scholarship winners. No person can win a second time if there is a first time application. No scholarship committee family member will be eligible to apply.
- 4 If no one qualifies for the scholarship this year, the funds will be held and used for scholarship(s) the following year.
- 5 If the scholarship winner chooses not to further his/her education, the next highest score will move to first place, etc.
- 6 A letter of acceptance from the intended school or a proof of enrollment must be presented to the scholarship chairperson as soon as it is available.
- 7 The check for the scholarship will be made to the college, class or camp, etc. of choice.
- 8 The Four Beats for Pleasure scholarship will be awarded based on an essay and interview.
- 9 All decisions are made by the scholarship committee regarding scholarship applications will be final.
- 10 The winner(s) will be announced at the Saturday evening session of the Firecracker Jubilee.
- 11 All written applications must be received by June 25, 2010. All interviews will be conducted at the Firecracker Jubilee unless otherwise approved by the Scholarship Chairperson.
- 12 All interviews will be done at the show unless prior arrangements have been made.
- 13 Committee members will do judging of the written essay. The committee chairperson and the non-scholarship committee members will judge the interview.
