

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE POSTMARKED JUNE 15, 2010. A horse must be entered

In all classes you want to go in. Classes may be scratched at show with no penalty but any class changed or added will be charged the regular post entry fee of \$35. All show fee is per horse/rider combination only. For member only fee you must be a member by June 1, 2010. Additional riders must pay per class, either pre-entry or post-entry rate. . Payment in full or an open check must accompany entry or entry will be returned.

Individual Class fee:.....\$30.00 per class (Pre-entry)

(\$15.00 Firecracker Jubilee, \$15.00 Liberty Bell Classic)

Individual Class fee.....\$35.00 per class (Post-entry)

(\$17.50 Firecracker Jubilee, \$17.50 Liberty Bell Classic)

THERE WILL BE NO POST ENTRY ALL SHOW FEE. ALL SHOW FEE ONLY AVAILABLE THROUGH PRE-ENTERING.

ALL SHOW FEE AND INDIVIDUAL CLASS FEES INCLUDE BOTH SHOWS.

(Show Classes cannot be separated!)

1A. Poles, Barrels, and Water Glass must ride once for each show. Therefore Poles 24, 25; Barrels 26, 27; Water Glass Adult 9, 68; and Water Glass Youth 10, 69 each count as one entry for payment purposes.

2. Horse must be entered on entry form for each horse/rider combination with copy of negative coggins test, registration papers, and TWH, SSH, Racking, NWA, Amateur/Trainer or youth card must accompany the entry form. If this club has any record of a previous bad check you must send a certified check or money order. **No Back Number will be issued without complete information and an open check or payment in full. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

3. STALL FEES are \$75.00 per stall for 2 days with 2 bags of shavings, or \$50.00 per stall per day with one bag of shavings included. Stalls will be ready for use Thursday at noon and must be vacated Sunday morning unless prior arrangements have been made with the show manager. Stall assignments are on a first come first serve basis. In case of emergency please leave your name and phone number where you may be reached during the show on your stall so show officials may get in contact with you should there be a problem with your horse.

4. Grounds Fee is \$15 per horse per day for show if working out of trailer and not using a permanent stall for the show. Coggins must be displayed on trailer.

5. Additional shavings may be purchased through the Barn Manager for \$7.00 per bale.

6. HORSE SHOW OFFICE will close (2) hours prior to the scheduled starting time of each session. Championship classes must be entered no later than 4:30pm on Saturday July 3rd. Classes not entered by that time will be charged an additional \$10 late entry fee per class entered.

7. REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES AND STALL FEES may be made minus a \$20.00 office charge per horse upon request before the pre-entry closing date. After the closing date refunds may be made upon request if illness or lameness occurs. Show office requires a certificate issued by a veterinarian on official letterhead stating illness or lameness before the start of the show. Entry fees may then be refunded minus a \$20.00 office charge per horse. Entry fees may be transferred to a substitute horse at no charge.

8. THE FOUR BEATS FOR PLEASURE CLUB INC will not be liable for any accident, loss, damage, or injury that may occur to an Exhibitor, Owner, Trainer, Agent, Groom, Individual, or Spectator sustained while at the Firecracker Jubilee Horse Show or the Liberty Bell Classic show.

9. The Four Beats For Pleasure Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself of declining to

receive any Exhibitor, horse or groom without penalty of compensation.

10. This is a show for **SOUND HORSES ONLY!** Any lame or sore horses will be disqualified from competitions in the show no questions asked and forfeit all entry and stall fees. All breeds of horses will be checked in by the DQP before each class and the first place horse will be checked immediately following the class.. No chains, action devices, plastic wrap, leg wraps or hoof bands will be allowed on the grounds or in the stalls or in the show ring.

11. Persons on federal disqualification cannot transport horses to this show and can only participate as a spectator. If any federally disqualified persons are apparent in the outside of the spectator area, they can be directed to the spectator area.

12. Camper Spaces with full hook-ups are available for \$30.00 per day or any part of the day. Sign up with entry and space assignment will be determined by the Show Secretary.

13. The 2010 Firecracker Jubilee/Liberty Bell Classic are affiliated with the National Walking Horse Association (Sound Horse Show). The NWA rule book will prevail.

14. The Firecracker Jubilee and Liberty Bell Classic Horse Shows will follow the TWHBEA Versatility rules.

15. Country Pleasure horses may not enter any other TWH division. **TWH Trail Pleasure** horses may not enter TWH Lite Shod or TWH Plantation divisions.

16. SSH and Racking Horses shall follow their own association rulebooks accordingly. Except Racking and SSH will not be allowed to have hoof bands!

17. Classes specified Youth are for exhibitors 17 and under as of January 1, 2010.

18. Classes specified adult are for exhibitors 18 and older.

19. In the Jumping Classes any English attire, hardhats, footwear with heels, English equipment, and either a snaffle, kimberwick, or pelham bit are required.

20. Refunds or accounts deemed payable will be processed and mailed with in 30 days after the conclusion of the show.

21. To be eligible to compete in Championship classes the entry must have been paid, entered, shown and judged in the qualifying class.

22. Novice Classes are for novice horses and novice riders, neither horse nor rider has received three blue ribbon prior to entry date closing June 15, 2010.

23. All Showmanship at Halter entries may not be asked to do the pattern it is the **Judge's Choice.**

(ALL DRESSAGE, TRAIL OBSTACLE, IN HAND OBSTACLE, OBSTACLE DRIVING, PLEASURE DRIVING, HUNTER HACK, AND OVER FENCE CLASS MUST BE PRE-ENTERED.) CLASSES WITHOUT 3 ENTRIES WILL NOT BE HELD.

The NWA now requires all exhibitors with the exception of entries in the Country Pleasure Division to have a NWA Show Card in all shows affiliated with the NWA. Show cards may be purchased with entry to show.
